No/F-49/1/2007/42-1 In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 38, read with Section 37 of the Rajiv Gandhi Proudtyogiki Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniyam, 1998 (No. 13 of 1998), the State Government hereby makes the following first Statute for the Rajiv Gandhi Proudtyogiki Vishwavidyalaya, namely: -

STATUTE-36

1. **Short title and commencement:**
 - (1) This Statute may be called the Rajiv Gandhi Proudtyogiki Vishwavidyalaya (**Constituent College/Polytechnics**) Statute, 2007;
 - (2) This shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Madhya Pradesh Gazette.
2. **Definitions:** In this statute, unless the context otherwise requires;
 - (a) “**Adhiniyam**” means the Rajiv Gandhi Proudtyogiki Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniyam, 1998 (No 13 of 1998);
 - (b) “**Constituent College/ Polytechnics**” means an affiliated College/Polytechnic declared as Constituent College/ Polytechnics of the University by the Executive Council with the concurrence of the concerned authority which is managing and maintaining the College / Polytechnics. Such Constituent College/ Polytechnics shall be maintained and managed by the Rajiv Gandhi Proudtyogiki Vishwavidyalaya,
 - (c) “**Employee**” means every whole-time officer, teacher or other employee of the University appointed permanently to a substantive post and

includes those appointments on contract for a definite period of not less than three years but does not include persons whose services have been lent to the University by Government;

- (d) **“Statute”** means the Statute made under the provisions of Section 37 and 38 of the Rajiv Gandhi Proudyogiki Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniyam, 1998 (No 13 of 1998);
- (e) **“Section”** means Section of the Adhiniyam;
- (f) **“State Government”** means the Government of Madhya Pradesh;
- (g) **Words and expression** used but not defined in this statute shall have the meaning as assigned to them in the Adhiniyam.

3. **Objects of declaring as Constituent College/ Polytechnics:-**

The following shall be object of declaring as constituent colleges/ Polytechnics

- (a) to provide the desired **Academic and Administrative Leadership** to propel the growth and development of the institution.,
- (b) to create the desired environment and develop the strategic framework to pursue a path of **Excellence in Technical Education.**,
- (c) to lay a firm and everlasting foundation for growth of **Quality Technical Education** in the Institution.,
- (d) to develop the institution as a model for **Curriculum Innovation and Examination Reforms.**,
- (e) **development of professional and moral values in the faculty**, students and the staff.,
- (f) to foster the growth of well informed knowledgeable and talented manpower to work in knowledge technology driven systems and enterprises.,
- (g) to facilitate **synergic partnership** with the Industries of the state and the country.,
- (h) for transforming technical education into a vibrant and **dynamic system.**,
- (i) to foster **Research Culture** and promote industrial consultancy.,
- (j) to foster **international and national collaboration** for academic programmes for research and development,

4. **Absorption / Integration of Teaching and other Staff of the affiliated College/ Polytechnics, which is proposed to be declared as constituent: -**

There shall be a option for the staff to take the permanent absorption in the University Services and those not willing for absorption, their services shall be taken on deputation, in the first instant as per the rules of the State Government and of the College Management as the case may be. All the posts available in the budget of the college shall be transferred by the appropriate authority or the institution to the University.

The faculty and staff of the Constituent College/ Polytechnics shall be treated at par with the University Teaching Departments of the University.

5. MANAGEMENT OF THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION

For all purposes, the sustenance and development of the constituent institution shall be a responsibility of the university. In fulfilling its responsibility, the university shall:-

- (a) recruit and develop faculty of the constituent institution,
- (b) investment in the development of the institution,
- (c) encourage revenue generation in the institution through various means,
- (b) formulate the institution budget and manage its finance
- (e) provide governance to the institution through the university executive council.

6. Status of the Students/ Courses

All the students shall be treated as the students of the University Constituent College/ Polytechnics.

All the courses of the concerned institution admitted to the privileges of the university, shall be continued and treated as the courses of the Constituent College/ Polytechnic.

7. Transfer of the movable and immovable property of the College/ Polytechnics

As soon as the College/Polytechnic is admitted to the privileges of the University as Constituent College/Polytechnic all its assets and liabilities movable and immovable property with the entire land roads and building shall stand as transferred to the University and shall be treated as University property in all the records maintained by the Revenue Department other Corporate Agencies, subject to the approval or the State Government. The University shall not be bound to pay any cost towards this property.
